*Did you know that this year, almost 7,000 people will die while waiting for a lifesaving transplant organ? These lives could be saved.*

*Did you know that Medicare would save \$5 billion annually if all eligible patients on the waiting list received kidney transplants instead of being on dialysis? You can be part of the solution.*

The American Transplant Foundation is the only national nonprofit that provides lifesaving financial assistance grants to transplant patients in need, regardless of their legal status. With donations given for the Patient Assistance Program, we:

The one-time emergency financial grants awarded to patients are a maximum of \$500.  
**Your donation in that amount is guaranteed to help at least one transplant patient.**

Members of the Transplant Leadership Council (TLC) carefully review all grant applications to ensure that grants awarded have the greatest impact on patients' lives. We encourage you to raise funds as a group or to make a pledge payable over 12 months (\$42 monthly.)
