Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged & Disabled (PAAD)– New Jersey

You may be eligible for **PAAD** if you meet the following requirements:

- A New Jersey resident;
- 65 years of age or older or 18 years of age or older and receiving Social Security Title II Disability benefits; and
- Annual income for 2018 of less than \$27,189 if single or less than \$33,334 if married; and
- Medicare-eligible PAAD beneficiaries are also required to enroll in a

Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plan in New Jersey.
